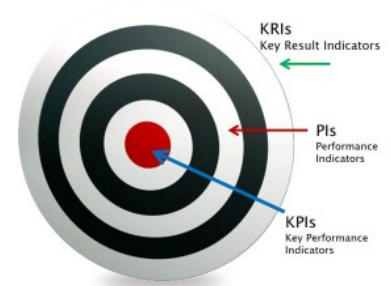
KPI Assessment Form

To understand Key Performance Indicators, it's important to understand what they are, and what they are not.

- KPIs should be limited to approximately ten (10) in number, and will be mostly operational
- KPIs should be reviewed weekly, at the very least, and mostly on a daily basis
- KPIs keep business owners and business managers awake at night, and if they're lucky enough to fall asleep, they're those things that they want answers for when they wake up in the morning
- KPIs are the center, or "heart" of your business, and define what is necessary to keep your business "pumping"

There are other "Indicators" to be reported on, but they are not "Key Performance Indicators"

- Performance Indicators – Performance Indicators can usually have up to 80 metrics that look at key indicators such as profitability of top clients
- Key Report Indicators – Key Report Indicators tell us how we have done in the past, and usually include material from your Board package or monthly reports
